

FAMILY PHYSICIAN OR NURSE PRACTITIONER

If your concern is not critical or life-threatening, call your Family Physician first. They may have same-day appointments available if your concern is urgent.



URGENT PRIMARY CARE CENTRE (UPCC) OR WALK-IN CLINIC

If you do not have a Family Physician or they are unavailable, try a UPCC or walk-in clinic.



PHARMACIST, 8-1-1 OR FH VIRTUAL CARE

For health advice, you can call 811 to speak with a Registered Nurse. For urgent medication needs, contact your pharmacist or call 811 between 5pm and 9am. Fraser Health Virtual Care can be reached at 1-800-314-0999. They can connect you with the care you need and are open 7 days a week from 10am to 10pm.



EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

If your condition is critical or life-threatening, call 911 or go to your nearest Emergency Department.

FAMILY PHYSICIAN OR NURSE PRACTITIONER

- fever
- starting a new medication
- cuts and minor sprains (weight-bearing)
- complex and/or ongoing health concerns
- minor coughing and colds



UPCC OR WALK-IN CLINIC

- no Family Physician or none available
- evening, weekend and holiday needs
- new or worsening condition/ailment
- minor wounds
- connection with community health services



PHARMACIST, 8-1-1 OR FH VIRTUAL CARE

- urgent medication refills
- questions about whether or not to visit a doctor
- connection with community health services
- minor illnesses
- contraception + some other prescriptions



EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT

- major accidents
- severe abdominal or chest pain
- heavy bleeding
- loss of consciousness
- difficulty breathing
- sprains that can't bear weight

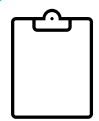
